InfraCo Asia's Project Highlights

Ninh Thuan Solar Power Project reaches operations Developed in partnership with

Sunseap International, it is one of Vietnam's first utility-scale solar power projects to reach operations, in Ninh Thuan Province in June 2019.





Philippines Smart Solar Network Pilot energises a community InfraCo Asia, together with BISELCO, AIEC-ILAW, and developer team Infunde marked its first smart solar network project to reach operations, in Busuanga, Palawan, Philippines in September 2019.



Ba Lai Water Supply Project achieves financial close

In partnership with Darco Water Technologies, InfraCo Asia achieved financial close on the Ba Lai Water Supply Project, part of the Vietnam Water Supply Portfolio, in Ben Tre Province in November 2019.



Kha Laing Microgrid Pilot Project breaks ground

InfraCo Asia, together with project partners EDF and SolaRiseSys, and with the support of developer team ICM, broke ground on the pilot phase of the Myanmar Rural Electrification Services project in the Magway Region in November 2019.



IJGlobal's APAC Hydro Power Deal of the Year Award

In March 2019, the Coc San Hydro Power Project received IJGlobal's top honour for APAC Hydro Power deals. InfraCo Asia brought the Coc San project from distressed asset to high-performing plant, divesting its shareholding in the project to TEPCO in November 2018.



Capacity Building

InfraCo Asia increased its capacity-building efforts, aimed at helping increase the skills and available tools for key aspects of the infrastructure industry in south and southeast Asia.

InfraCo Asia's initiatives include a multilateral PPP roundtable in Vietnam, a ministerial-level techno-commercial feasibility training on wind power in Myanmar conducted by the developer team ICM, a three-day annual workshop on risk management, compliance and development impact and more.
